

## Wedding Welcome to Santa Barbara, CA

The best of Santa Barbara (besides the Nelson/Scoby wedding, reception, and barbeque) are the beaches and waterfront. Plan on going down to the harbor, watch the people, and enjoy the sunsets. There are bars and restaurants at both the boat basin harbor and Stearns Wharf. From the wharf, head up State Street for more restaurants and shops.

Plan a trip to the Santa Barbara Mission, the “Queen of the Missions” established in 1786 by Spanish Franciscans. Open daily from 9am-5pm. 2201 Laguna St.

Santa Barbara has a zoo, a botanical garden, and half a dozen museums worth visiting, depending on your viewing preferences.

If you will be here for more than a few days, consider touring some of the wine country. Many of the local wineries have tasting rooms.
